On 1/18/05 at 1:30 PM the Maintenance Mechanic for the Harlow Primate Lab was doing a walk-through of the Lab and noted that the area around the ramp hallway on the south side of the building was very cold. He noted that there was a heat register located at the end of this hallway near the outside door but it was not functioning. He call in a steamfitter to access the situation and it was determined that the steam to that particular register was turned off down in room 21 (the mechanical room). The valve was not labeled as to what areas it served but it was determined that it was connected to the heat register in the hallway so was turned on to assist in keeping the area warm. What the mechanic, steamfitter and I did not know, was that the steam was also connected to heat registers in the storage shed that is usually unheated. When the steam was turned back on, the pipes that had not been in use for 15 years did not hold and large amounts of high pressure steam were released into this storage area. It was not discovered until the morning of 1/19/05 so considerable damage was done before it was even noticed. The steam was subsequently turned back off and the valve labeled.
